How can the federal budget help small business?

Tax cuts would be good for smaller businesses.

Be able to get cash-flow incentives.

I think it's very easy to open a business in Australia everything is done online and you don't have to do it through an accountant.

So tax cuts, whilst I don't think they are a massive issue for us at the moment they may well be when we grow our business.

And I think small businesses would even be willing to pay a little bit more tax if it was a flat rate of tax that they could very simply calculate.

Getting investment into small businesses, getting them confident and the cash flow back in is probably more important to us than the regulation.

I think if there was some more assistance for micro-sized start-ups that would be fantastic.

It would be great to be aware of what grants are out there.

Some things that Australia has are great, like the R&D tax credits but they are not really accessible for small businesses.

It is really important as the global economy is still uncertain that we do get again that cash-flowing through small business which is the lifeline of the economy.
